Dean D. Goldsack presented the report to Senate.

that Senate adopt a policy on common final exams for multi-sectioned courses in Science and Engineering as follows:

- all multi-sectioned (including language sections) Science and Engineering courses have a common final

examination for the term in which the sections are offered.

- a similar method of determining final grades (including the same weighting factor for the final exam) will be adopted for all sections of the same course.
- this common final exam will be made up and marked by a committee of all the professors teaching the various sections of the course.
- in order to prevent bias in the marking of the final exam, it will be marked by assigning in an equitable manner, individual questions to the various professors teaching the different sections.

The motion was carried unanimously.
