

- IV. that Senate endorse the policy on the Public Documents Collection adopted by the Senate Library Committee:

Policy on the Public Documents Collection

- (i) that the public documents section of the library include both government and non-government documents;
- (ii) that a government document is any document originated by any level of government, a government agency, or any combination of governments, or any combination of governments and government agencies; and that the government documents collection should include reprints of government documents, even those printed privately;
- (iii) that non-government publications (categories 6 and 7 of CODOC: publications of national institutions, society and association publications, publications of political parties, and commercial firm publications) may be included in the public documents section of the library;
- (iv) that a specialist be designated with prime responsibility for public documents;
- v) that the CODOC system continue to be used in the public documents section for the present.
