

THAT the March 17, 1994 Senate resolution on exam postings be revised to read "that past examination papers be made available to students and that these examinations be accessible through the library in electronic format. An exemption can be authorized **ON A COURSE BY COURSE BASIS** by the Senate Committee on Teaching and Learning and that these exemptions be brought to the attention of the Library as it can post the reason for the absence of the examination. In addition, exemptions should be reviewed by the Senate Committee on Teaching and Learning before November of each academic year.

RATIONALE:

To exempt an entire department or programme from posting previous exams in the library is a disservice to students. While there may be exams which are difficult to

change from year to year, it is inconceivable to think that an entire programme could be affected in this way.
